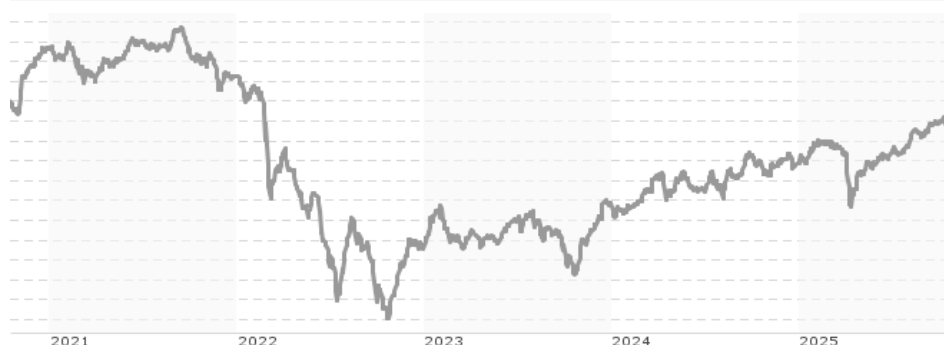

Investmentstrategie

The investment manager will actively select, purchase and sell securities with the aim of meeting the investment objectives of the Fund. The Fund will invest primarily in debt securities issued by corporations. The Fund may also invest in government securities, quasigovernment entities and money-market securities. The Fund may use derivatives with the aim of managing interest rate and currency risk more efficiently. The Fund may also use derivatives for both hedging purposes and for taking investment positions. These may include short positions where the Fund seeks to benefit from the sale of an asset that it does not physically own.

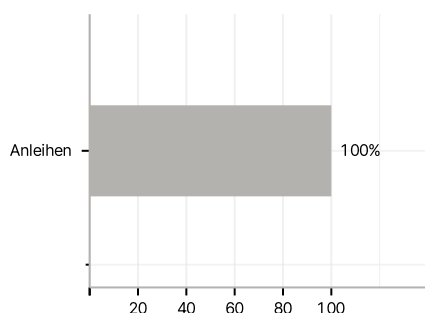

Investmentziel

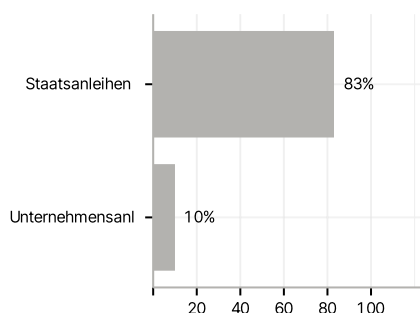

Veranlagungsstruktur

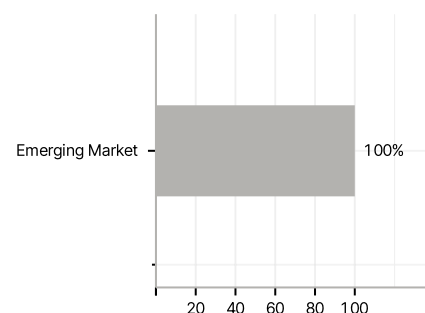
